

Club Purpose:

To provide the building and flying of radio controlled model airplanes and helicopters in a safe and responsible manner.

Information about the Club:

Mile HI RC Club is a privately owned and operated club. Individuals interested in flying Model Aircraft are encouraged to visit and join our flying community.

The club has been in existence for over 40 years. It is one of the first Radio Control Clubs to be chartered by the **ACADEMY of MODEL AERONAUTICS** (www.modelaircraft.org) in the United States.

Since our inception, the club has grown from a handful of RC enthusiasts to over 60 members at the present time. Our current members range in age from 12 years old to 90 years old including male and female pilots demonstrating all levels of flying skills.

For interested newcomers and novice pilots we have several instructors available, and at no cost to club members, during the week and on weekends for those individuals who want to get their wings.

AMA Information:

Academy of Model Aeronautics is the governing body of model aviation. It supports and promotes our hobby through contests, demonstrations of flying skills, education, adoption of school programs and provides liability insurance for both Chartered Clubs and for its Member RC Pilots.

All individuals flying at our Mile HI RC Club site must be a current Member of the AMA or supervised by one of the Club Designated Intro Pilot Instructors.

Club Meetings:

Mile HI RC Club meetings are held, periodically, on the 2nd Wednesday of the month, at Aurora Fire Station #11 which is located at 2291 So. Joliet St. (on E Iliiff Ave and east of Havana St). These meetings are open to the public. Additionally, those individuals interested in our club can find the meeting minutes posted on the club web site. Topics include club business budget, contest coordination, flying field improvement, model aircraft building hints, and guest speakers and programs.

How To Get Started in RC Flying:

Now that you have decided to get involved in Radio Controlled Flying, come on out to the Club Flying Field for a hands on experience. On the weekend, club instructors are normally available to answer any questions that you might have. You may even be able to fly with the help of a club instructor using a trainer aircraft and get the experience of a lifetime. Getting involved in this exciting hobby comes with a lot of technical questions that need to be answered. If you are planning to buy radio control equipment, we strongly urge you to stop by our flying field and or attend our club meeting so that you can benefit from the experience of our club members.

We will gladly advise you of the right equipment to purchase so that your introduction to the thrill of RC flying will be a pleasant one. After you have purchased your equipment, we can advise you in the building, setup and maintenance of your model aircraft, its engine and electronic equipment. Club instructors will guide you from your takeoff and landing efforts through your solo flight. After you have gained proficiently in flying your aircraft, several club members will be more than willing to help you through the more advanced piloting skills of performing aerobatic maneuvers with your RC aircraft. These skills may even prompt you into competing in radio Control Aerobatic Contests.

Club Field Amenities:

After 20 years at our old flying field, we moved In '2009 to our new location. Our new flying field is on leased farm land that is virtually flat. The field is surrounded by a fence and has a security gate with a combination lock. Our Geotextile runways are oriented east-west and it is 600 feet long by 60 feet wide.
