Club Purpose:

To provide the building and flying of radio controlled model airplanes in a safe and responsible manner.



Information About the Club:

Mile HI RC Club is a private members only club. Individuals interested in flying model aircraft are encouraged to visit and join our flying community.

The club was founded over 50 years ago! It is one of the first radio control clubs chartered in the USA by the Academy of Model Aeronautics (www.modelaircraft.org)

Since our inception the club has attracted many members and presently has members with skills ranging from beginners to highly advanced.

We offer flight instruction for novice pilots and offer instruction by our members at no cost. We will help you get your wings!

Academy of Model Aeronautics (AMA):

AMA is the governing body of model aviation here in the USA.

AMA supports and promotes our hobby through education (STEM), adoption of school programs, contests, demonstrations of flying skills, and provides liability insurance for both chartered clubs and member RC pilots.

All individuals flying at the Mile Hi RC Club site must be a current member of AMA or supervised by a club designated intro Pilot.

Club Meetings:

Club meeting dates, times and locations will be posted on our website. During summer months the meeting may be held at our flying field location. The meetings are open to the public.

Club Flying Site:

Our flying site is located east of Aurora on the north side of Quincy Ave (CO-30) 18.5 miles east of E-470.

Club Field Amenities:

Our location is on leased farm land and is virtually flat.

The field is surrounded by a fence and that is secured by a combination lock. Our main east-west runway is a geo-textile material that is 600 feet long by 60 feet wide. (Our website has an aerial view of our runway.)

There is a pit area that is 300 feet by 30 feet that is also covered with geo-textile material.

There are many start-up benches for the aircraft as well as a safety start-up area for giant scale aircraft.

We have a sheltered break area for pilots and guests that offers some protection from the elements in all weather conditions in addition to picnic tables and a barbecue facility.

We also have a large storage trailer where we keep supplies and some equipment. There is also a port-a-potty located on site.

We have ample parking for autos, trucks, trailers and motor homes.

Club Membership:

Club Membership is open to anyone interested in building and flying radio controlled model aircraft.

Anyone flying at our field must have a current AMA membership and present proof of AMA membership.

Club members must observe all club posted flying site rules as well as the AMA safety code.

Each new member will receive a club patch and name tag.

Club apparel (hats, shirts, jackets, etc.) may be purchased by individuals.

Beginner pilots will be offered Flight instruction by our designated AMA Intro Pilots at no cost.
